The May Revision is a statutorily required action by the Administration every year, and this will be the second year for Governor Gavin Newsom to recast his January State Budget proposals and present new proposals in view of a revised revenue outlook and stakeholder feedback. The May Revision Workshop will incorporate the results of revised revenue estimates, finalize the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) provisions for 2020–21, revise the out-year estimates for LCFF funding for your multiyear projections, provide the latest on funding and policy proposals outside the LCFF, and incorporate any revisions of the accountability system.

As expected, 2020–21 is shaping up to be a very interesting year for school administration and finance. This workshop provides the information needed to close the books for 2019–20 and to finalize local educational agency budgets for 2020–21, both of which are assured to be full of changes.
