The May Revision Workshop will incorporate the results of revised revenue estimates, finalize the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) provisions for 2020–21, revise the out-year estimates for LCFF funding for your multiyear projections, provide the latest on funding and policy proposals outside the LCFF, and incorporate any revisions of the accountability system.

In this unprecedented public health crisis, 2020–21 is expected to be a very challenging year for school administration and finance.
